

Gloss Installation

Materials:

- **Protect-All Gloss sheet goods**
- **Approved Protect-All Floor Epoxy (PA127 or PA139)**
- **1/16 x 1/32 x 1/32 V-Notch Trowel**
- **Appropriate welding material (Protect-All Rapid Weld)**
- **Approved water sealant (E6100)**

Process:

- **Remove all debris from the substrate including any loose pebbles, nails, etc.**
- **When moving the sheets, do not roll the sheets tighter than a 1' diameter. It may damage the surface.**
- **Maintain directional arrows similar to matte finish.**
- **Keep the factory cut edges next to each other with no gap between the sheets.**
- **Pull the sheets back and apply the adhesive to the substrate using the above mentioned trowel quickly remove any adhesive that comes through the seams.**
- **Roll the sheets with a 100 pound roller; use Gorilla Tape to pull the sheets together and keep everyone off of the floor until the initial cure time is completed.**
- **Keep everyone off the floor for the initial cure time as prescribed by the specific adhesive used. (12 hours-PA127, 6 hours-PA139)**
- **Groove seams and weld using Rapid Weld. Heat welding cannot be done on gloss material.**
- **Finally, cover the flooring with cardboard to protect the surface before the end user takes possession of the area.**
